- Additional Electrical Instructions -

Regulations now govern the electrical installations at most UK venues. A full list is available from the venue.

The most permitted are listed below:

1. All labour working on electrical installations must have proof of their competence, i.e. BECA registered or JIB approved.
2. Only one four way trailing outlet (maximum 500w) per socket outlet may be used.
3. Flexible cord (Round Cable) may not be longer than 2 metres.
4. ELCB protection is required for each socket less than 2 metres (measured horizontally) from any sink unit / water outlet.
5. Any complaints regarding electrical installations must be reported in writing before the close of the exhibition.
6. Unless supplied with drawing the installation will be fitted at the electrician's discretion.

For Information: Examples of Power Requirements

500w Socket-Computers, TV's, Videos, Spotlights up to 500w, Fridges.

1000w Socket-Domestic filter coffee machines, Lighting up to 1000w.

2000w Socket-Kettles, Machinery up to 2000w.

3000w Socket-Hired coffee machines, machinery up to 3000w.

NB. Lighting circuits must not exceed 1000w.

Please Note: 500 w sockets are suitable for use with a Single 4x Way Adaptor to run Mobile Phones, Computers, TV's, Pop Up Stand Lights etc ALL sockets over this size to be used with a single item.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT EXPO EROTICA

The agreement below sets out the General Terms and Conditions as a recognizable Contract between you (The Exhibitor) and Maring Events Ltd; Trading as Expo Erotica, as (The Organisers) as they relate to the Expo Erotica 2024 Event.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1/ The Organisers reserve the right and shall not be held liable should (due to unforeseen circumstances) it becomes inevitable to postpone the Event to other dates as near as possible to the original dates, and/or close the Event for a period of time should it be deemed necessary to do so.

2/ Unless otherwise agreed upon beforehand (in writing), all Exhibition spaces will be determined by the Organisers. The Organisers also reserve the right to amend or change the location and position of the Exhibitor stand should it be deemed necessary to do so.

3/ The Exhibitor adheres to comply with all rules and regulations stipulated by the Organisers, the Venue, Health and Safety, the Fire Department and all relative bodies relating to the safe conduct of persons for the duration of the Event.

4/ Should the Exhibitor fail to comply with any of the terms and conditions within this agreement the organisers reserve the right to re-allocate the Exhibitors space as they see fit. This does not absolve the Exhibitor from any financial obligation towards the Organisers and No Refunds will be given.

5/ The Exhibitor is not permitted under any circumstances to erect any sign, screen, banner or structure that is deemed to encroach on an adjoining Exhibitor space.

6/ All exhibits and displays must be erected at least Two Hours before the opening of the Event. The Exhibitors are not permitted to dismantle or remove partial displays of said exhibits before the closing time at the end of the Event.

7/ Neither the Organisers or the Venue Owners/Staff are in any way responsible for the safety and well being of the Exhibitors stand, equipment, display, goods and products or anything else relating to their exhibitor space, which is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor. This also includes the set up and dismantling time periods. However, the Organisers will do everything in their power to provide a safe and secure working environment for the Exhibitors, their staff and their belongings for the duration of the Event.

8/ Neither the Organisers or the Venue Owners/Staff are to be held liable for any loss or damage sustained by the Exhibitor or any other person in relation to structural/water damage to the venue, fire, storms, protests, acts of war or terrorism, civil disturbances, strikes, walk outs, industrial action, force majeure or any other accidental or unforeseen circumstance which result in the postponement and/or cancellation of the Event. The Exhibitor acknowledges that they are wholly liable for any costs and expenses should any of the unfortunate circumstances above arise.

9/ The Exhibitor is not permitted under any circumstances to cause any structural damage to the floor, ceiling, walls or any part of the venue or another Exhibitors space or stand. The Exhibitor will be liable for any damages incurred whether deliberate or in error.

10/ The Exhibitor hereby agrees to accept responsibility for all acts or omissions whether intentional or in error related to their time at the Event. This also includes conduct by members of their staff, team, contracted workers, entertainment acts, visitors and guests. The Exhibitor also undertakes to take responsibility and indemnify the organisers against any liability in respect of all actions, law suits, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, expenses or whatever that may be made against the Organisers, in

respect of any act, show, demonstration, product sample or any other matter that the Exhibitor has engaged in or supplied to a member of their team, participant or attendee at the event. This includes any expenses (legal or otherwise) incurred by the Organisers to cover the costs to defend them selves in any action brought about by any of the above situations.

11/ It is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor to leave their stand space clean and tidy both during and after the Event. The fee charged by the venue for any rubbish that is not disposed of responsibly and in the correct manner will be passed directly on to the Exhibitor.

12/ All artwork for any promotional material needs to be submitted at least two months prior to the event.

13/ The Organisers will endeavour to promote the Event and any further agreed promotions to the best of their ability. However the Organisers are not to be held liable for any spelling, punctuation, logo or image errors on material submitted by the Exhibitor.

14/ The use of gas, gas cylinders, dry ice, inflammables and noxious substances of any kind is expressly forbidden around and within the Event space.

15/ The Exhibitor acknowledges that they must undertake to ensure that all stands, fittings, furniture, draperies, decorations etc are constructed of materials approved in the Rules and Regulations for Public Entertainment, and that all the aforementioned items shall be non-flammable in accordance with the current statutory rights and regulations.

16/ The Exhibitor acknowledges that they must bear the installation cost of any and all special equipment provided by the venue that is required for the purposes erecting and/or maintaining their Exhibition stand, and that a description of any fitments with plans be submitted no later than 60 days prior to the Event.

17/ The Organisers reserve the right to stop any activity on the part of the Exhibitor that may cause annoyance to other Exhibitors or Visitors, and that business must only be conducted from the Exhibitors own stand and in no way from the gangway or anywhere else within the Event space unless previously agreed in writing by the Organisers.

18/ Unless otherwise agreed by the Organisers, there will be no use of the PA System or Touting. The Organisers however will be happy to make scheduled PA announcements on behalf of an Exhibitor to announce start up times for activities, giveaways, prizes etc.

19/ In the interest of Public Safety all Gangways and Public Areas must be kept clear of stand equipment, products etc. Any goods to be found encroaching on these spaces will be removed by the Organisers who will be exempt from any losses that are occurred.

20/ Unless otherwise agreed with the Organisers all publicity and promotional material must only be displayed and/or given away only from the Exhibitors own stand.

21/ The Organisers shall not be liable for any injuries, losses or damages caused to any persons while visiting the Exhibitor stand, and the Exhibitor agrees to indemnify the Organisers in the event of any claim arising from such an eventuality.

22/ The Exhibitor is admitted into the Event space on the understanding that photographs and film will be taken with a view to promote future Expo Erotica events in an appropriate manner.

23/ Exhibitors are admitted to the Event and shall remain there solely on the strict compliance of the Terms and Conditions set out above. The Organisers reserve the right to reject or request that anyone causing a Public or Offensive Nuisance exit the Event space. No antisocial behaviour will be tolerated and No Refunds will be given.

24/ The Exhibitor undertakes that there will be No Exchange of Business Cards for Sexual Favours and/or Purposes.

25/ Failure by the Exhibitor to vacate the venue after the proposed deadline will result in a penalty of £500 per hour.

CO-EXHIBITORS

It is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor to inform the Organisers of any Co-Exhibitors that will be occupying an Exhibitors space.

a/ The Exhibitor acknowledges that they are solely responsible for supplying the correct Company and Insurance Documentation prior to the event for any and all Co-Exhibitors.

b/ The Exhibitor also acknowledges that unless agreed in writing by the Organisers, an extra charge may be levied for any and all Co-Exhibitors

c/ The Exhibitor further acknowledges that any and all Co-Exhibitors adhere to the conditions of this contract in full for the duration of the Event, and that the Organisers are not held liable in any way, shape or form, should these conditions not be met.

PAYMENTS

a/ Deposit of 50% paid within 30 days of the Invoice date will be required to secure your booking.
This deposit is non refundable.

b/ Payments are to be made Net of all Bank Charges.

c/ The balance of the payment must be made within two months of the date of the event and must be accompanied by a copy of the Exhibitors PLI Insurance documents.

d/ Applications made within three months prior to the event must be paid in full.

e/ Exhibitors will not be permitted to occupy any stand or space unless the full amount has been paid by the due date shown on their Invoice.

f/ Should the Exhibitor fail to make their payments by the due dates, the Organisers reserve the right to re-sell the space and any monies paid by the Exhibitor to the Organisers are to be considered forfeited.

CANCELLATIONS

The Organisers may consider a Cancellation of the Exhibitor Contract if:

a/ A request is submitted by Registered Post at the business address provided on the Invoice, and an acknowledgment of confirmation is made by the Organisers thereafter.

b/ That the request is made before the two month period prior to the event.

c/ The Organisers are successfully able to re-allocate the entire space to another Exhibitor/s.

Out of Respect to the Event, the Exhibitors and the Attendees, the Organisers undertake to:

a/ Confirm that all the necessary documentation pertaining to the Law, Health & Safety, Venue and the event in general have been scrupulously adhered to.

b/ Promote the Event to the best of their ability by utilizing all legitimate resources available to them. One of these means may be to engage the services of a well known personality and/or celebrity. In an attempt to safeguard the promotional integrity of the event for all concerned, these persons will only be engaged via a signed contract. However, despite the good intentions of the Organiser the Exhibitor hereby recognises and acknowledges that there can be no claim against the Organisers, if for whatever reason, the promotion results in a cancellation or No Show from the aforementioned persons. In the event of any such cancellation or misdemeanour the Organiser will endeavour to do their best to engage a suitable replacement to promote the event.

c/ Provide a safe and positive environment within to conduct the event.

d/ Undertake to preserve the privacy and safeguard any personal or business information provided by the Exhibitor accordingly.

Law of Contract: The Contract is governed in all respects by the law in which the Event is being held and any legal action arising from this contract shall be litigated only in England.

By Ticking and Signing the Box above I/we agree and abide by the Terms and Conditions set out in the above Contract. I/we agree to indemnify Maring Events Ltd (Trading as Expo Erotica) against any claims arising from loss or damage to Exhibits and/or walls, floors, ceilings, doorways, fittings or furnishings caused by us, our agents or contactors of the Event Venue during the move in, occupancy and move out periods.
